BACHELOR OF MEDICINE AND BACHELOR OF SURGERY (MBBS)

Curriculum at Bakhtawar Amin Medical & Dental College conforms to the regulations and recommendations of the Pakistan Medical & Dental Council. In addition, courses tend to emphasize the development of communication, information technology and interpersonal and management skills.

Medicine and surgery courses are very demanding. Faculty at Bakhtawar Amin helps students to gradually develop their technical skills on a base of academic teaching about the biology of the human body. Bakhtawar Amin Medical College endeavors to provide facilities to its students to be the best in their fields.

None of these developments would have been possible without the unflinching support of the Trustees and donors. I feel privileged to place on record my deepest appreciation and gratitude to them.

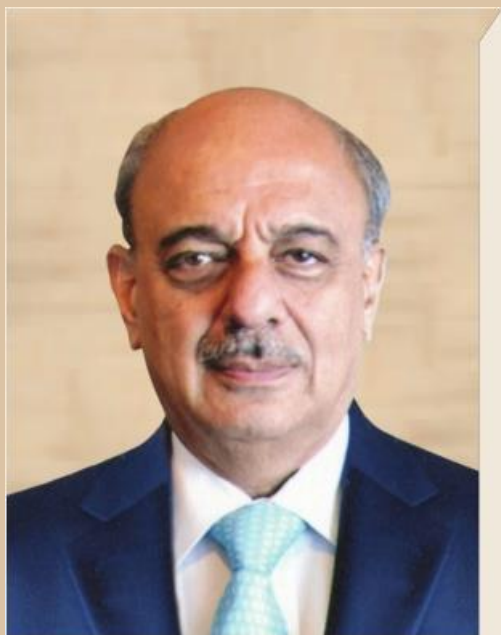

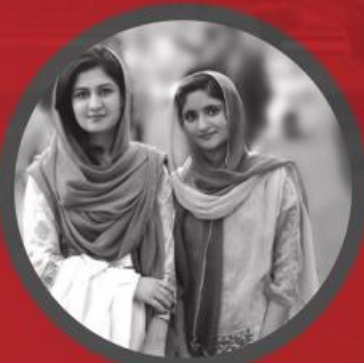

A State of the Art Hospital in Multan

BAKHTAWAR AMIN TRUST HOSPITAL

A teaching hospital is an essential component of a medical college. Bakhtawar Amin Medical & Dental College boasts of its own 500 bedded on-site hospital. Bakhtawar Amin Trust Hospital started functioning in 2006 as a 300 bedded primary and secondary healthcare facility and now it has been upgraded to a 500 bedded teaching hospital.

This purpose built hospital is designed as a tertiary care teaching facility. It will provide comprehensive health care, not only to the surrounding urban and rural areas, but also to other cities and towns.



BAKHTAWAR AMIN MEDICAL & DENTAL COLLEGE

Bakhtawar Amin Medical College is constructed on the Northern Bypass Multan. This purpose built campus has ample space for future extension. Vast lush green lawns and trees add to the environmental beauty.

Basic Sciences Departments are housed in a four storey academic block. There is a separate three storey library/IT block and an auditorium block. Each basic department has been designed for 150 students per class in accordance with PM&DC requirements. The college has five lecture theatres, six tutorial rooms, five museums, seven state of the art laboratories, a dissection hall, a skills lab, a multipurpose hall and a separate hall for the department of medical education. The 750 seat state of the art auditorium adds not only to the aesthetic beauty of the building but also provides the much needed facility for national and international medical conferences, symposia & seminars in Multan. The auditorium block also includes a spacious cafeteria for students, separate common rooms for boys and girls and a restaurant for staff.

Histology Laboratory:

To familiarize the students with microscopic structures of different tissues, we have a modern histology lab equipped with all teaching aids including multi head and projection microscopes.

Dissection Hall:

The spacious hall fulfills the PM&DC criteria for 150 students per class. Here the students can dissect cadavers and learn the subject on human body. The dissection hall is complemented by a good mortuary.

Museum:

The museum has on display latest models and dissected specimens. The students can learn on latest models of anatomy. The dissected specimens illustrating various structures further add to the understanding of students on real human body.

The first contact of a Medical student is with the Anatomy department. Knowledge of anatomy is highly relevant to the study of medicine. This is especially obvious when performing anesthesia or surgical

procedures and when using various examination methods. For this reason, a solid knowledge of anatomy is fundamental to the physician's daily work. The Anatomy Faculty at Bakhtawar Amin Medical College endeavors to equip the students with adequate knowledge for understanding the structural components of the body responsible for carrying out normal body functions. The student is empowered to use the Anatomy knowledge to understand and appreciate the other subjects taught in the College and to understand the basis of common clinical conditions. Faculty at Bakhtawar Amin Medical College works to create a feeling in the student that their journey towards making of a doctor has started.

Due to the pivotal position of the subject of Anatomy in the field of medical science, Bakhtawar Amin Medical College Anatomy department is completely equipped to cater to all the training requirements of students.

Students are made to recognize the practical relevance of the curriculum during their preclinical courses. Interest of the students is generated through interactive methods and clinical relevance of the knowledge of basic anatomy is illustrated by using, PowerPoint presentations and quizzes.

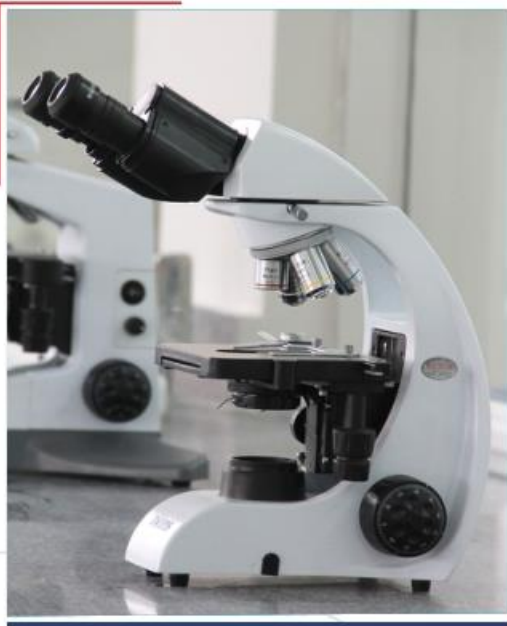

The course highlights the relevance of basic physiology to clinical practice through use of clinical examples. The students are taught not only the functions of individual systems but also the interaction among various systems.

The subject of biochemistry covers various chemical actions and their application to solve important biomedical problems. Applications of the knowledge of biochemistry in the laboratory for the diagnosis of diseases; in the manufacture of products (like insulin, growth hormone, interferon etc.) from genetic engineering; and in the possible use of gene therapy have tremendously benefited mankind and their living styles.

Pathology is a branch of medicine, which deals with acquisition, progression and outcomes of various diseases in the form of laboratory investigations. Learning of pathology enables the students to understand the nature and complications of a disease or injurious agents and thereby helps in building a good foundation in every discipline of medicine. Pathology is a bridge between the basic and clinical subjects. The knowledge of pathology will help students to become good physicians and render efficient clinical practice.

The Pathology Faculty at Bakhtawar Amin Medical College endeavors to equip the students with adequate knowledge and understanding of the mechanisms and pathological processes of the production of diseases. Skills are developed in students to plan laboratory investigations in the diagnosis of diseases. Teaching is carried out through lectures, tutorials and practical demonstrations.

Bakhtawar Amin promotes development of attitudes in students for further learning and continuing education for improvement of efficiency and skill and for research in the subject. Emphasis is placed on developing skills to interpret laboratory results and understand their implications.

The department comprises of four sections of Histopathology, Hematology, Microbiology and Chemical Pathology.

Pharmacology is the science which deals with knowledge about medicine embracing their interaction with living beings and the effects they produce, including their mechanisms of action, uses and adverse effects. Pharmacology is therefore the study of what medicine does to the body and what the body does to the medicine. Use of medicine benefits the patient but there is always the risk of adverse effects. A knowledge of Pharmacology is essential for

using medicine effectively and rationally in clinical practice.

The subject is taught to 2nd year MBBS students and the contents include chemical structures, absorption, distribution, metabolism, elimination, therapeutic effects and side effects of drugs. Interest of the students is generated through interactive methods and clinical relevance of the knowledge of basic Pharmacology is illustrated by using, PowerPoint presentations, quizzes, tutorials and practical demonstrations.

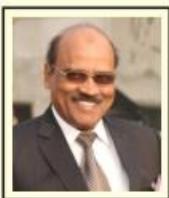

as their career would need to acquire a broad range of expertise as the general physician's assessment needs to be comprehensive. General physicians approach enables problems to be detected and diagnostic possibilities to be considered which might otherwise be missed. General physicians at Bakhtawar Amin use diagnostic tests logically, safely and effectively to investigate difficult diagnostic problems.

Apart from day to day IPD and OPD services, the department proudly started sub-specialty clinics in gastroenterology, pulmonology and dermatology providing diagnostic and interventional services on state of the art equipment. A broad range of specialties will be opened soon to cater to a large number of patients. The department is committed to serve as a hub for research and academic activities.

At Bakhtawar Amin students are also exposed to the social and psychological impact of diseases. They are trained in the critical analysis of research reports and the drug industry claims about new treatments. They are taught about complex interactions of medications given simultaneously to treat multiple illnesses in a patient.

Surgical Department comprises of General surgery, Urology and Orthopedic surgery. This department is offering services to all patients needing tertiary care.

General surgery as a specialty requires knowledge of and responsibility for the preoperative, operative, and postoperative management of patients with a broad spectrum of diseases. The faculty at Bakhtawar Amin endeavors to make the students aware of the decision making and communication skills required. The emphasis is on highlighting and demonstrating the competence required in diagnosis, treatment and management of different disease categories. The importance of documenting Preoperative History and Physical Examinations, Operative notes, in-patient progress notes, discharge summaries and assessment of patient risk factors is emphasized and exposure to proper documentation is provided.

Laparoscopic surgery is also carried out at Bakhtawar Amin which involves shorter stay at the hospital for the patient, less pain, less risk of infection, fast recovery and quicker return to normal activities.





DEPARTMENT OF OBSTETRICS & GYNAECOLOGY

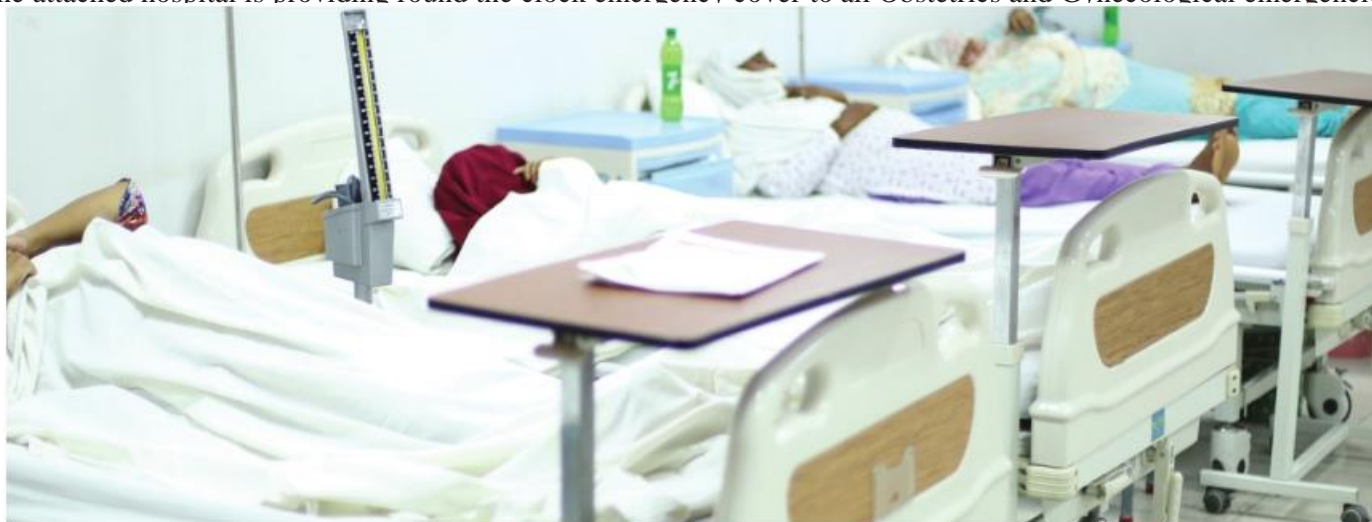


Obstetrics and gynecology are medical specialties that focus on two different aspects of the female reproductive system. Obstetrics deals with the care of pregnant women, the unborn baby, labor and delivery and the immediate period following childbirth. The consultants at Bakhtawar Amin ensure that mother and child get the best prenatal care to ensure labor and delivery is accomplished without complications and that should intervention be needed, it is done quickly and safely. Gynecology deals with any ailment concerning the reproductive organs; uterus, fallopian tubes, cervix, ovaries and vagina.

Gynecology encompasses specific surgical procedures related to female reproductive organs. The most common procedures are:

- Tubal ligation – a permanent form of birth control
- Hysterectomy- removal of the uterus
- Oophorectomy – removal of the ovaries
- Salpingectomy – removal of the fallopian tubes
- Cone biopsy -remove precancerous cells in the cervix identified during a pap test.
- The students are trained to acquire the necessary knowledge, skills and attitudes for appropriate and competent management of women with a wide range of conditions.

The attached hospital is providing round the clock emergency cover to all Obstetrics and Gynecological emergencies.

SKILLS LABORATORY

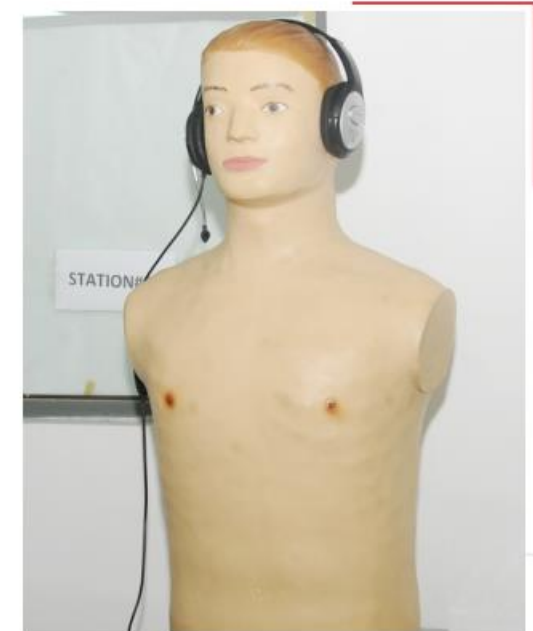

The lab will help to train students for diagnosis and management of diseases.





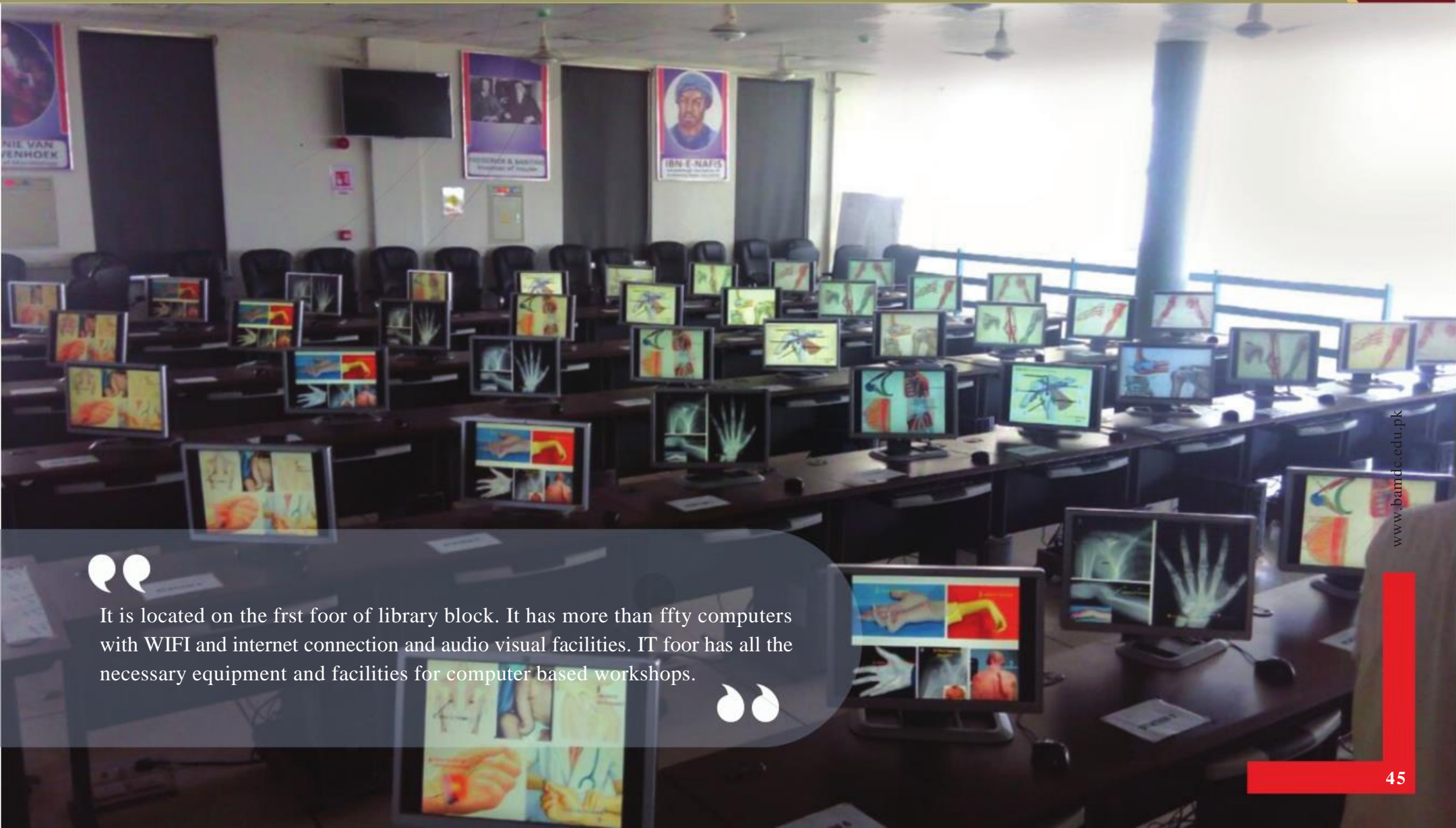
LIBRARY

However very soon A Class inhouse hostel facilities will be provided.



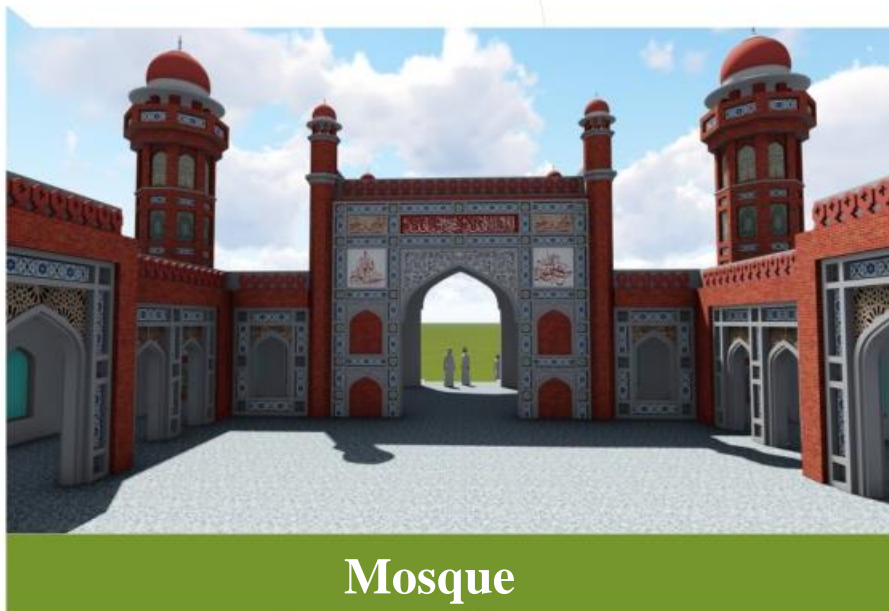
The new facility will be well-furnished AC hostels separate for boys and girls which meet the requirements of comfortable living for students. Visitor room, Recreation room with Music, Gym, TV rooms will be available for the students in their respective hostels.

A separate air-conditioned study room with internet facility will also made available for the students at their respective hostels. The hostel mess is designed and equipped to provides healthy and hygienic food for the students.

Applications for Hostel Admission shall be submitted to the ofce of Warden Boys/ Girls Hostel. In case of approval of Hostel admission, the candidates are required to pay, within seven days of the approval, prescribed fees on prescribed payment form.

Failure in payment of fees may result in the cancellation of Hostel Admission. After payment of fees, the resident shall have to sign the terms of allotment describing the Hostel rules and regulations. Messing and other amenities in the hostels may be availed on payment. Strict rules and regulations apply for residence in the hostel and students are advised to get a copy of these from the hostel warden at the time of allotment.





Mosque

There is a mosque in the Hospital premises, located near the gate. Temporary prayer area is also provided in the Academic Block ground floor. For female students, there is a separate prayer room. A new mosque will soon be constructed in the hospital premises.



ATM Facility

ATM facility is available within the Hospital premises. Soon full-fedged banking with lockers facility will also be available.



Book Shop

Book shop is available in the college premises. All books needed by the students are made available at market price. It is the discretion of the students to purchase books from the shop.

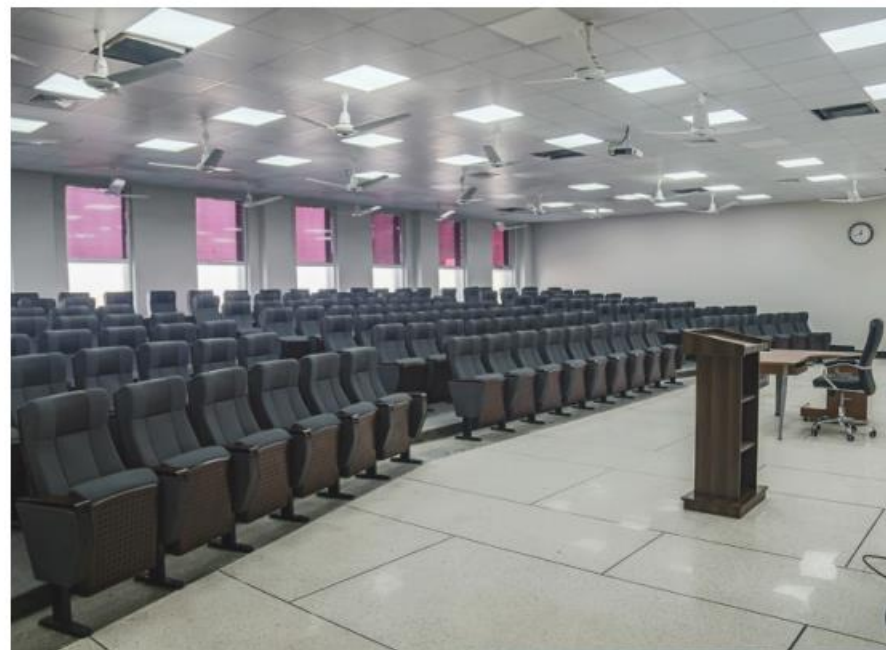


Lecture Theatres

Pharmacy

Spacious pharmacy store is available round the clock for OPD, IPD and walk in patients. Computerized inventory and billing system with all latest medicines are available in the store for the use of patients who are prescribed medicines by the Bakhtawar Amin doctors. The central Pharmacy procures drugs and equipment from manufacturers through the distributors. Qualified pharmacists supervise the pharmacy at each step.

The Pharmacy is connected to the pharmacology department headed by the pharmacology HOD with the facilities of Pharmacopoeias, National Formularies, important text books & journals.

Museum

Museums display labeled specimens, charts, models and other material concerning communicable diseases, Community Health, Environmental Sanitation and etc. are provided for the reference of students in the museums.

Skill Labs

State of the art skill laboratory has been provided at Bakhtawar Amin. It is meant to teach various skills to students via instruments and dummies, which helps students later on in their careers to provide high quality patient care.





ADMISSION PROCESS & POLICY



Pakistani

Students born, raised and educated in Pakistan.

Foreign / Overseas Pakistan

Students carrying foreign passport /Green Card and having passed examinations from foreign University/board.

Admission to the MBBS programme is made strictly on merit under the guidelines laid down by PM&DC and the University of Health Sciences Lahore. Students from all provinces of Pakistan, Islamabad, FATA & overseas can apply for admission. The admission process and policy recorded below is subject to any changes or directions which may be mandated by the PM & DC.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

As per PM&DC criteria, an entry test shall be mandatory for admission in MBBS course in Pakistan and shall be taken of only the eligible candidates. The candidate shall have to appear in the provincial entry test or entry test of the admission authority. The candidate is required to have passed the F.Sc. (Pre-medical) Examination from a Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education in Pakistan with at least 60% unadjusted marks or passed an examination with equivalence of 60% or above in F.Sc. as determined by IBCC* or have passed SAT II examination with minimum 550 marks in each of the three subjects of which two have to be Biology and Chemistry or MCAT with minimum aggregate score of 24.

ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

Foreigners and Pakistanis having dual nationality/ residential status of a foreign country shall be eligible for foreign admissions irrespective of the place of their pre medical study. Only those Pakistani nationals and foreigners who have obtained the required qualifications for the entry test are eligible. They shall either

have to appear in the entry test of the UHS or in lieu thereof, the entry test of the institution. TOEFL or IELTS score of 500 or 5.5 shall be required from the students who have obtained their required qualifications from those institutions where the medium of instruction for these qualifications is not English. An alternate to TOEFL and IELTS is a certification by NUML Islamabad after one year English language course.

RULES GOVERNING PAYMENT OF FEE

- Admission and tuition fee once paid are only refundable as per PM&DC policy
- Applicants should seek clarification about fees/other dues from Admission Ofce before applying
- Fees and other charges are payable in advance before the start of academic session
- Students defaulting in fee payment may be suspended and / or barred from the classes and examination until the clearance of dues in accordance with the College policies and procedures
- Students will not be allowed to appear in any university examination unless all outstanding dues are fully cleared prior to the registration deadline of the examination
- Any further additional charges levied by the Government, the University of Health Sciences or the PMDC during the course of studies will be charged from the students
- Hostel and mess charges by the boarders and transport charges by the day scholars will be paid in advance for the whole year

BAM&DC Entry Tests/Interview

The candidates who fulfill the minimum academic requirements

for admission are short listed for Institutional Entry Test / Interview.

The Interview will be held at Bakhtawar Amin Medical and Dental College. Candidates will be

tested for the aptitude, communication skills and English language skills of the applicants.

Age Limit

Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PMDC) has abolished the age limit for admission to MBBS/BDS. There is no minimum or maximum age limit for admission to medical and dental

IMPORTANT RULES & REGULATIONS (EXAMINATIONS)

Pass marks for professional examinations are 50% separately in theory and practical of each subject. In the clinical subject, 50% of marks for clinical part separately are essential to pass in practical. A student shall be declared successful only if he/she passes in all components of examination (theory / practical / clinical) at the same time.

Before appearing in the University Examination, the student will be required to produce 'No Dues Certificate' from the College Cashier, College Librarian and Hostel Warden and the College and Hostel Tuck shop contractor. Students who are unable to produce the same are liable to be detained by the head of the institution from appearing in the university professional examination.

No student shall be allowed to appear in any university examination unless he/she has attended at least 75% of the lectures, demonstrations tutorials and the practical or clinical assignments in every subject. Extra classes organized by various departments may be counted towards calculation of attendance percentage.

In case the student fails in the Professional Examination in annual as well as supplementary examination, his/her provisional promotion to the next higher class shall stand automatically cancelled and he/she shall revert to the previous class and the academic credits earned during his/her provisional promotion shall also stand cancelled.

If a student appears in the supplementary examination for the first time as he/she did not appear in the annual examination and fails in any subject in the supplementary examination, he/she will be detained in the same class and will not be promoted to the next class. Promotion on CARRY ON basis will not be allowed under any circumstances.

The student will have to pay fee for the detained year according to the number of subjects in which the student has to reappear.

The head of institution reserves the right to detain any student from appearing in the Professional Examination of the University at any stage. If in his/her opinion, the student is found to be short of attendance in Theory or Practicals of any subject or the student's work is reported to be unsatisfactory by any professor, lecturer or if in the opinion of the head of the institution the character and conduct of the student is unsatisfactory.

Award of Grace Marks or any such increase in marks in any other manner is not permissible under any circumstances.

University of Health Sciences has introduced Objectively Structured Performance Evaluation (OSPE) in its affiliated institutions to eliminate bias favoritism and victimization in viva voice, practical and clinical examinations.

There is zero tolerance for use of unfair means in examinations.

Note: Any student who fails to clear the first professional M.B.B.S Part II examination in four chances availed or un-availed after becoming

REGULATIONS FOR INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

Students will be governed by PM&DC and UHS rules & regulations for examination as modified from time to time.

- Continuous Internal assessment shall consist of evaluation at the end of each assignment, e.g., stage/sub stages, class test etc., and attitudinal assessment by clinical supervisors. Whenever applicable by yearly Log Book will be important reflection of student performance.
- Term test and Send-up assessment are important components of internal assessment.
- Assessment of Knowledge, Skill and Attitude shall contribute towards internal assessment. Methods used to assess these domains shall include multiple choice questions of one best type, Short essay Questions, Oral Viva, and practical/clinical Examination.
- The Weightage of Internal assessment shall be 10% in all Subjects. 5% Internal assessment marks shall be added to the aggregate score of theory and 5% Internal assessment marks to aggregate score of Oral and Practical Examination and not to an individual component like MCQs, SEQs paper or Oral / Practical/ Clinical Examination.
- The Score of Internal assessment shall contribute 10% and the university examination contributes 90% to total score. The candidate shall pass in aggregate.
- Send Up examination 4-6 weeks before the annual university examination shall be compulsory for students of all classes. Students who do not appear or fail in the examination will be regarded as students whose course of instructions are incomplete and unsatisfactory and will not be allowed to appear in the university professional examination for promotion to the next higher class. Pass percentage for Send Up examination is 50%.
- Award of internal assessment in the all the subjects of the candidate shall be submitted to the controller of examinations along with Admission Form for the professional examination. Internal assessment received after commencement of the final examination shall not be accepted.
- The marks of internal assessment shall be submitted only once a year prior to the annual examination and the same shall be counted both for annual and supplementary examination.
- It is further emphasized that fresh assessment or a revision of assessment for supplementary examination shall not be permissible.
- Proper record of continuous internal assessment shall be maintained by respective departments of the medical college.
- Internal assessment award in a particular year may not be decreased subsequently detrimental to the candidate.





LIFE AT CAMPUS

The college administration will organize trips for the recreation and education of students.

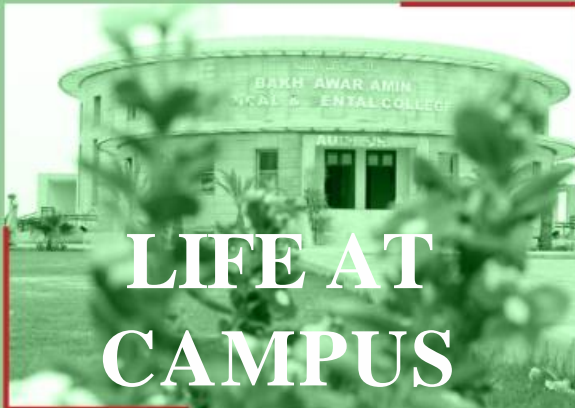
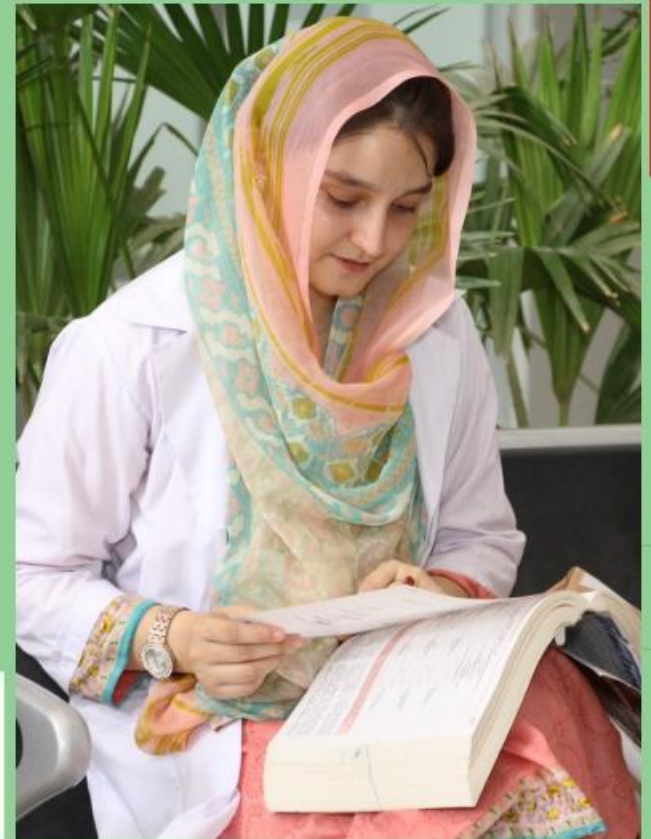

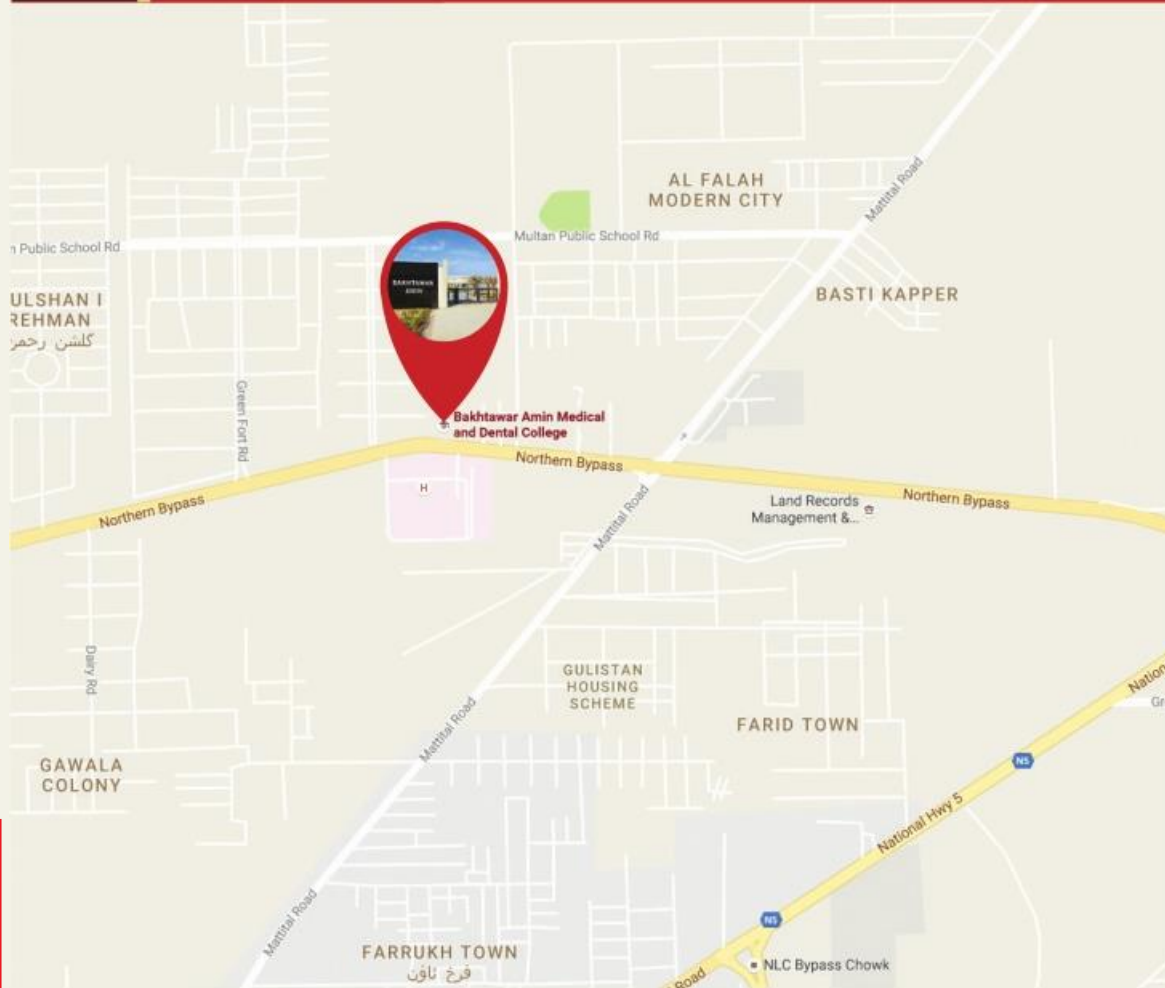
